

our gratitude. An oven with a five ringed hob has been, installed and with a little re-arranging has created more bench space which has improved the facilities for cooking up to 200 meals per week. The positive response from Brian and John for making this daily task a little bit easier was most pleasing for the Trustees.

Arrangements have been made to build fixtures in the back of the new vehicle to house the new



equipment for use at the Newcastle kitchen.

The work behind the scene gathers pace during the summer months as the Trustees get to grips with the ever changing rules and regulations of working practices and the Charity Commission. There are monthly meetings between Brian and John with a sub-committee of Trustees, and the same sub-committee meet at least once per month which addresses any issues raised.. On three or four occasions during the year all the Trustees meet to deal with items which require their approval.
