born in Hartlepool, christened as a baby, misbehaved as a child, was in and out of jail for minor offences, and who got into drugs, and was sent to prison for supplying.

He became a Christian 12 months ago and is now clean from drugs and drink. At present Andrew is selling the Big Issue in Stockton, has acquired a flat in Middlesbrough and is looking to further his qualifications. We are delighted that he is now baptised. Praise The Lord.

Our thanks again to all who support us with prayers, money, food and clothing including blankets. These come from individuals and churches as well as firms such as Sainsbury's of Washington and Barclays at Doxford Park, and now a

Bakery at Chester-le-Street. Our bus has required medical attention over the past few weeks, and it is thanks to everyone that it is now back on the road and we can manage to help the increased numbers we are witnessing. Grateful thanks go to Hope House at Newton Aycliffe who allow us the use



of their kitchen to prepare the hot food and place it into thermal flasks to keep it piping hot. I would also like to mention Xcel Church of Woodham Village who do so much in the spiritual and social activities which take place, and for use of their mini bus for these occasions.

This year's Walk for Walter's Work took place on Saturday 21st of June when 37 walkers and a child in a buggy travelled


